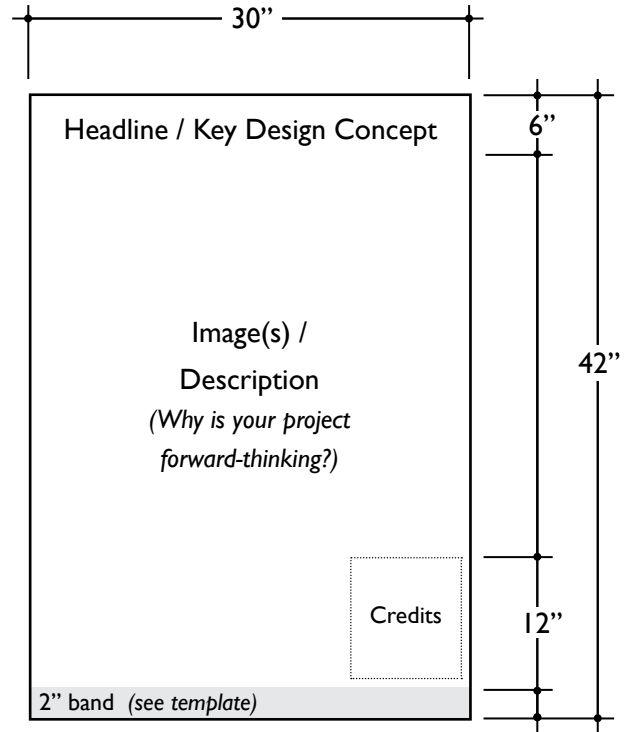
Each board will present one project. Please use template provided.
