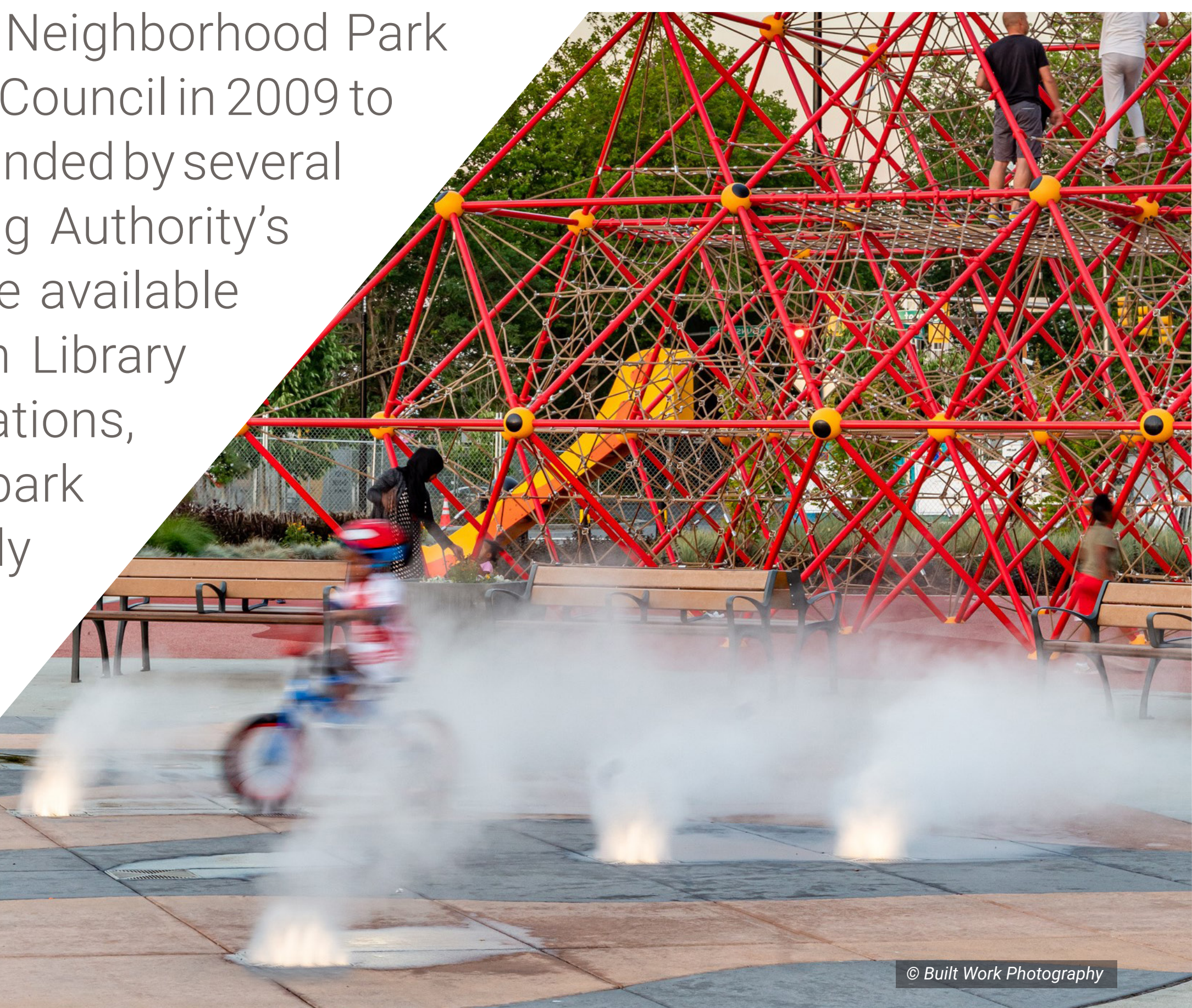




# City of Renton Sunset Neighborhood Park

Renton, WA

Located within a community that lacked access to open space, the 3.7-acre Sunset Neighborhood Park supports the Sunset Area Community Investment Strategy adopted by the Renton City Council in 2009 to equitably distribute infrastructure improvements throughout Renton. The park is surrounded by several blocks of multi-family and single-family housing, including a mix of Renton Housing Authority's affordable housing, ensuring a variety of housing types, for rent and ownership, are available for all income levels. Directly adjacent to the park, a King County Regional Branch Library reinforces the civic function of the park. Within less than a half mile, Bus Rapid Ride stations, three K-12 schools, and retail/grocery services connected via sidewalks ensure the park is the heart of a walkable community. The park provides multiple benefits previously missing in the neighborhood, including: gathering spaces for community events; outdoor recreation for residents; increased economic vitality of nearby businesses; significant storm water treatment; and opportunities for social interaction.
