





PROJECT DESCRIPTION:


In 2024, Seattle Theatre Group (STG) began hosting a concert series at Remlinger Farm, an agrotourism destination along the banks of the Tolt River near Carnation, Washington. Mithun and STG teamed to reimagine a concert goer's Club Experience. The ongoing project includes cohesive brand-aligned amenities, furniture, fixtures, equipment, and planting to support the concert venue's existing performance space. Due to the venue's proximity to the Tolt River, all elements of the project (except planting) are temporary - intended to be disassembled and stored at the end of each summer season. The venue aims to become the first Salmon-Safe Certified concert venue in the country.

PROJECT HIGHLIGHT:

The temporary pavilion, assembled from off-the-shelf scaffolding and printed shade fabric, shelters a fifty-foot-long community table and provides a backdrop for audience seating, field games, food and beverage bar, and various outdoor lounge spaces. Zones of 'superbloom' native meadow plantings are massed in the landscape bringing native ecosystems into the heart of the event experience.
