




## Notes

Students may take courses in addition to those listed above. Full-time tuition fees apply when taking between 7-18 credits. Any credits over 18 credits require additional tuition fees. Students with loans should check with the UW Financial Aid Office about minimum credits required per quarter, if applicable.

Only 400-level and above courses may fulfill MLA/MUP degree requirements.

The minimum credit requirement remains at 105 regardless of waived coursework. Total credits may exceed the minimum total.
