LENGTH OF PROGRAM

The standard timeline for BLA students is 9 quarters (or three years). However, students who enter the program with mostly completed general education requirements and significant progress towards BLA degree requirements may pursue an accelerated 7-quarter (two years plus one summer/autumn term) course sequence. When you enter the program, the Undergraduate Program Adviser will assess which sequence makes the most sense for you.
